One of two luxury properties the couple own in the area, the impressive rural retreat has four bedrooms, two bathrooms and is set over an expansive 25 acres where it is surrounded by a subtropic rainforest.

Contemporary, elegant and with a refined European edge, the home was originally a set of horse stables built in the 1920's but has been extensively renovated by the pair.

Dotted with pieces from Dinnigan's extensive travels, it features many of the designer's signature touches including hardwood timber flooring, exposed beams, galvanised iron cladding and clean, crisp interiors.

Other features of the home, which the couple purchased in 2013, include a loft-style master bedroom suite, exquisite entertainment barn with pizza oven and seating for 20, an alfresco dining area and an outdoor bar and fire pit.

The property, which was available for rent via accommodation service AirBnB, also comes with its own social media presence courtesy of an Instagram account that has nearly 3000 followers.

Located just five minutes from the seaside towns of Milton and Mollymook, the property is listed for sale through Simon Platt from Unique Estates with price expectations above \$2.95 million. Expressions of interest close March 24.
